The way this program works is simple. You as a “grandparent” agree to attend one of our summer camps for the entire session. Although you are housed separately from the campers, you will spend most of the day with them. You eat meals with them, share with them in worship and small groups, and just talk one-on-one during free time. The purpose of your being at camp is to establish a personal relationship with the campers. In other words, we want you to share yourself with the campers.

The qualifications are important:

You must enjoy being with children of the age level of the camp you attend.

You must be in good enough health to stand up to the activities of camp (mostly lots of walking and no air conditioning during the day).

You must be willing to share yourself with others.

You will be provided with semi-private sleeping accommodations with air-conditioning, good nutritious meals, and free time to rest if you choose.
